

CORDEVALLE RANKED NO. 1 RESORT IN NORTHERN CALIFORNIA

SAN MARTIN, Calif. (October 18, 2012) ... CordeValle, a Rosewood Resort, has been ranked the No. 1 resort in Northern California by Conde Nast Traveler, in the magazine's 2102 Readers' Choice Awards, unveiled in the November issue.

CordeValle's score landed the No. 8 ranking in the U.S. poll, and No. 29 position in the World poll.
