The Tower Fitness Center has an expansive workout area with cardiovascular fitness machines and a weight room, plus a 65-foot lap pool.

The Sportsplex, which opened in 2009, includes eight tennis courts (four indoor, four outdoor), two indoor racquetball courts, locker facilities and café. It also houses the Golf Dome, which features 40 hitting stations, two simulators and a short game practice area and the Golf Superstore at Turning Stone.
