Location: Colonial Williamsburg's Golden Horseshoe Gold Course is located in the

Tidewater region of Virginia, an hour's drive from Richmond or Norfolk, 150

miles south of Washington, D.C., off interstate 64.

Renovation: Numerous new improvements will ensure Golden Horseshoe Gold Course remains one of the top golf destinations in the nation. Re-opening on July 1.

- All fairways and tees have been re-grassed with new Northbridge Bermuda grass
- Roughs re-grassed with Northbridge Bermuda grass
- Greens re-grassed with 007 bent grass
- All greens rebuilt to USGA specifications
- Greens on holes 2, 6, 12, 18 completely rebuilt to adjust severe slopes
- All bunkers completely rebuilt with the Better Billy Bunker technique and new sand (SF 35)
- New forward tees built on holes 3, 4, 6, 9, 10, 13, 14, 15 and 17
- Drop areas rebuilt on all four par three holes
- Tees laser leveled and fairways smooth graded
- New short game practice area added with chipping areas and practice bunker
- Driving range fairway improvement include re-grading and target greens
- Extensive drainage improvements on selected holes
- Irrigation improvements throughout the course
- New practice putting green built, doubling the existing size
- Selected trees removed and underbrush cleared out

Gold History: Designed by the legendary Robert Trent Jones Sr. and opened in 1963, the

Gold Course is a superior example of traditional classic golf course

architecture. Jones Sr. called it his "finest design."

In 1998, Rees Jones was the architect of a course renovation that remained faithful to the original design that expanded the appeal of the course for higher-handicap players while simultaneously lengthening the course from

the back tees.

Green Fees: Green fees vary seasonally, ranging from \$69 to \$190

Membership: A variety of golf memberships are available at the Golden Horseshoe--from

non-resident to young executive. Membership packages include pro shop discounts, food and beverage discounts at the Gold Grill, complimentary club storage, advanced tee time booking seven days a week, and reduced guest

fees.

Clubhouse: Gold Clubhouse renovations, scheduled for June 2017 completion, will

include redesigned ladies' and mens' locker rooms, expanded lobby with museum-quality golf artifacts display, and new full-service bar and lounge

area.

Lodging &Overlooking the Gold Course, the signature Williamsburg Inn underwent a multimillion-dollar renovation that added a new signature.

underwent a multimillion-dollar renovation that added a new reflecting pool centered on the front lawn arrival oval; enhancements to the rear patio terrace; additions of an outdoor bar, fire pit lounge and formal fountain; expansion of the outdoor Queen's Terrace, adjacent to the popular East

Lounge, and the addition of a wedding pagoda and event lawn.

Across England Street, the Williamsburg Lodge recently added Sweet Tea & Barley, a refined yet casual regional dining experience in the lounge area near the historic hotel's original fireplace. New terrace dining is just outside

with heated umbrellas and fire-pit tables and year-round seating.
