

# Make The Most Of A Visit To the KPMG Women's PGA Championship

How to get there and have a fun, safe time at Westchester Country Club, June 9-14

**Harrison, N.Y. (June 2, 2015)** - With the inaugural KPMG Women's PGA Championship—a unique collaboration of KPMG, the PGA of America, and the LPGA Tour, and golf's only major championship in the New York Metro area this year—about to start, here are some helpful hints to make the most of one's visit to watch the top female golfers in the world.

### **Public Parking**

Free parking for the public is available at 333 Westchester Ave., White Plains, N.Y. 10604. Complimentary shuttles will be provided from all public lots to the Main Entrance Gate.

Note: There will be no stopping or dropping off at security checkpoints, and tailgating is not

permitted in the public parking lots.

### By Train

Daily, complimentary shuttles will also run from the Rye Train Station to the Main Entrance Gate. The shuttle pick-up and drop-off are on the south side of the station (main parking lot side).

Note: There is no reserved parking in the train station lot for tournament spectators.

## By Taxi, Limo, and Car Service

Spectators arriving by taxi, limousine, or car service should be dropped off at the public parking lot at 333 Westchester Ave., White Plains, where there will be a designated drop-off and pick-up area. From the parking lot, visitors must take the free shuttle to the Main Entrance Gate.

There will NOT be drop-off or pick-up at Westchester Country Club unless accompanied by proper parking credentials to a designated lot.

### **Mobility Impaired Parking**

Designated parking for wheelchair-bound spectators will be provided; please call The Convention Store at (877) 472-7275 for more information. Wheelchairs will not be available for rent, but spectators may bring wheelchairs with them to the Championship. Wheelchair-accessible viewing areas will be located at the front right of hole #1 tee and to the left of hole #18 green.

### **Mobile Device Policy**

Those wishing to use their mobile devices will be asked to adjust the volume setting to "silent" or "vibrate" while at the Championship.

- Guests may accept or make phone calls in designated "Phone Zone" areas throughout the golf course, primarily near concession stands.
- Digital messaging and checking data is allowed on the golf course.
- Mobile device camera use is ONLY permitted during Practice Rounds and NOT permitted during Championship Rounds.
- No video recording will be permitted at any time during Championship Week.

Spectators attempting to use their mobile device in unauthorized areas or in ways not sanctioned will be asked to surrender the device and pick it up at a designated location after they depart the golf course.

### Items To Leave At Home

The items listed below are strictly prohibited on the grounds of Westchester Country Club. All bags will be searched upon entering the Championship.

- Backpacks of any size.
- Bags larger than 10" x 10" x 10" in their natural state. Prohibited bags will NOT be accepted or stored at the golf course.
- Personal electronics such as, hand-held games, radios, televisions, iPods, etc.
- All oversized chairs with wide arm rests. Small, portable folding chairs are permitted.
   Carry bags will be searched prior to entry.
- Weapons of any kind (regardless of permit).
- Coolers, ladders, milk crates, signs, posters, banners, dogs and other pets.
- Food and beverages (including alcoholic beverages). One bottle of water with unopened seal per spectator is permitted.
- Other items deemed unlawful or dangerous by Championship Security personnel, at their sole discretion.

Please leave all prohibited items in your vehicle as they will not be permitted at the Championship.
