Guests on the patio can look out over a water feature, including a dramatic waterfall, or focus their attention on the wood-burning stone fireplace with a TV above the hearth.

A one-of-a-kind, natural grass putting course, lit for night play and perfect for friendly competition, is coming soon and sure to be a popular attraction located adjacent to the patio.

Cowboys Golf Club is an all-inclusive world-class facility open to the public for golf, dining, hospitality, and private events ranging from weddings and golf tournaments to corporate outings. The golf course, which debuted in June 2001, was designed by award-winning architect Jeff Brauer on a pristine natural setting of 159 acres, just 30 minutes from downtown Dallas.
