Combining a renowned legacy in golf with his own dynamic approach to architecture, he has designed more than 275 golf courses in more than 40 countries on six continents. His courses have won countless awards and accolades, been ranked among the best layouts throughout the world, and hosted tournaments on every major golf tour, including five World Cups and a Ryder Cup.

Jones is a member of the California Golf Hall of Fame; a long-standing member, former president, and current board member of the American Society of Golf Course Architects; former Chairman of the California State Parks Commission; and the recipient of many other industry awards and honors. He is the author of the book, *Golf by Design* (1993), and numerous articles and stories about golf course design around the world.
