

## Shhh ... Carmel-by-the-Sea's 'Secret Season' Is A Sunny Discovery

**CARMEL-BY-THE-SEA, Calif. (Sept. 21, 2016)** – Better known to locals as the "secret season," fall is the sunniest time of the year in Carmel-by-the-Sea. With average daytime highs in the 70s and evening temperatures in the 50s, a fall visit shows off this California coastal destination – in the midst of celebrating its Centennial – at its brilliant best.

A stroll or run on Carmel Beach, perhaps even a dip in the Pacific Ocean, is never more refreshing and comfortable than during the town's warmest season of the year.
