- **5. Brew Ridge Trail.** A burgeoning industry of craft breweries, distilleries, and cideries constitute the brewridgetrail.com. The sublime waters and plentiful locally grown ingredients offer an ideal combination for making refreshing beverages.
- 6. Tennis Anyone? Wintergreen has earned a Gold Medal Resort award as a Tennis Resorts Online "Top 25 Tennis Resorts and Tennis Camps for 2017." The resort has appeared among the top 30 tennis resorts in the country since the inception of the rankings in 2000. He designed and built Monticello, his classic hilltop home on the outskirts of Charlottesville and filled it with his unique inventions and all kinds of fascinating treasures. James Monroe, the nation's fifth president, lived with his family in Highland, an Albemarle "cabin castle" adjacent to Monticello.
- **9.** Nelson County. Thriving wineries, apple cideries, antiques and boutiques, peach and apple orchards are easily access off Virginia State Route 152, a short and scenic drive from Wintergreen Resort.
- **10. Chill**. Wintergreen Spa offers a menu of soothing treatments and unlimited access to the Wintergreen Aquatics and Fitness Center.
